

Kauni baby blanket

This was the blanket that I made with my first samples of Kauni effectgarn, and the colour effect was what won us over to carry the line. This blanket made the rounds during sales season, and was a big hit. Easy to make too! It is a simple domino square continued in rows, which means less ends to fasten.

Yarn: Kauni effect garn 100% wool. 2 balls or 300 grams. Shown in EQ.

Needles: 3mm ndls.

Measures: 7 rows of 6 squares each. Approx 73 x 81cm.

CO 59 sts. Work in garter st. Every right side decrease working with middle 3 sts: s1, k2tog, psso. Continue until 1 st left. Keep last st on ndl and include in pick-up sts, unless at last square on row, then pull through.

For first row of 6 sqs after first one: pick up 30 along top of previous sq, CO another 29 sts.

For next 6 rows: first sq CO 30 sts, pick up 29 along previous row of sqs. Then all other sqs pick up 30 from bottom and 29 from side.
