



Mobile-matching baby blanket

I took the free pattern from Rebecca Danger's website, and used the little monster chunks to make a crib mobile for my new little monster. You can find the pattern [here](#). It uses very little yarn, so I took the almost-full balls and made a matching blanket. If you don't make the mobile, then 8 full balls of Smart will go just a little bit further in each stripe, probably giving you at least a few more rows per colour. Just keep going until you run out!

Yarn: Smart 100% wool. One ball of each colour, minus what was used for mobile. Shown using from top down: 2005 (acid yellow), 4600 (fuchsia), 6733 (turquoise), 2708 (orange), 5229 (purple), 8514 (green), 5836 (blue), and 4219 (red).

Needles: 4.5mm straights or circ.

Measures: 81 x 62cm

CO 118 sts. K every row (garter) back and forth until you don't have enough yarn left to complete a full row. Slip first st as if to purl at the beginning of each row. I got at least 32 rows per colour. Make sure you consistently use odd or even amount of rows per stripe to make sure the transition row between stripes stays on one side of the blanket.
